Congratulations on your impending high school graduation and your contribution to Martin High School through your participation in the Martin High cross country and / or track & field programs. The purpose of this letter is to provide you with the opportunity to apply for one of the Martin High School Cross Country & Track Booster Club's scholarships that are awarded to deserving seniors who have participated in track & field , cross country or both for all four years of high school.

The application for the scholarship consists of an essay describing what you have learned through the cross country and / or track programs or how your participation in the cross country and / or track programs has made a difference in your life. Applications will be judged by the Scholarship Committee based upon the following criteria:

- 1) 50% content,
- 2) 25% neatness, and
- 3) 25% spelling and grammar.

The essay must be submitted with a cover sheet with your name and the years of participation. For example:

The essay must be between 200 and 500 words in length, typed (computer processed) and either turned into either Coach Mays' or Coach Hartley's office, emailed to jacobsb@ushg.cc or personally delivered to 4335 Vine Ridge Ct. (zip code 76017), with the cover sheet by Wednesday, May 5th at 3pm. If you email the application please make sure it is in a Microsoft Word format or in a readable PDF file. Essays that are late, do not have a cover sheet, or are not typed (computer processed) will not be considered. (All decisions regarding the qualification of your essay and cover sheet will be made by the Scholarship Committee and will be considered "final.")

Scholarship recipients will be announced at the track banquet. If you are unable to attend, you will be notified by mail. (Please be aware that this scholarship must be redeemed within twelve months from the date received or it will expire.)
